- The time of the gathering on 2/29 has been changed to **4:00pm-6:00pm**. The time for future gatherings might change again, so check back often for revisions.
- The focus of gatherings has changed to emphasize fellowship and conversation. As such there will not be a time of worship in song on 2/29.
